Urban climate informatics is an evolving research field that takes advantage of four technological trends to answer contemporary climate challenges in cities: advances in sensors, improved digital infrastructure (e.g., cloud computing), novel data sources (e.g., crowdsourced, or big data), and leading edge analytical algorithms and platforms (e.g., machine learning, deep learning). This keynote session will discuss the emerging trends in UCI and directions in addressing urban climate challenges using novel modelling analytics.

## Virtual platform

What platform is used to host the virtual poster event?

We use [Remo.co](https://remco.co) for *keynote and poster presentations* and [zoom.us](https://zoom.us) for the *ECR professional development sessions*.

No software downloads are necessary for Remo as it runs on your web browser. Prior experience suggests Chrome is the most stable while safari users reported difficulties last year. Unfortunately, Remo is not tablet-compatible.

How do I use the Remo platform for the virtual poster session?

Poster sessions will take place in a virtual poster hall called Remo conference. No software downloads are necessary; it runs on your web browser.

These instructions include:

- How to join the event
- How to move around the poster hall, find posters, and interact with poster presenters and other participants
- How to join keynotes and early career researcher sessions

**Note:** use the same email address you registered with when setting up your account in Remo.

### Where is each poster in the Remo platform?

The poster hall is set up based on the program agenda and the session themes. Each floor/level corresponds to a specific day of the event and the session themes for that day:

- Day 1: poster hall level 1-3
- Day 2: poster hall level 4-6
- Day 3: poster hall level 7-9

### Where can I find the location (floor and table number) of each poster?

Each table on each floor will be numbered and named prior to the session. Eg "ID-SURNAME TITLE". The poster ID and information will correspond with the poster program and abstract book.
